

Law Enforcement Officer Access to the MCOLES Information & Tracking Network

Effective October 1, 2007, access to the MCOLES Information & Tracking Network (MCOLES Network) is available to MCOLES licensed law enforcement officers upon request. Once access has been granted, each officer will be able to:

- view his/her own **Individual Profile**,
- search the MCOLES In-Service **Training Course Registry**,
- maintain his/her **MCOLES Network Password**, and
- create or delete a **Public Password** to allow his/her current employer(s) access to the Inquiry History.

The Individual Profile link directs the officer to the profile page and the individual employment history (IEH). The IEH contains information regarding the officer's license activation, basic training, standards compliance reviews, employment history, and in-service training as reported to MCOLES.

MCOLES Network Security Policy

Extensive efforts have been made to build and maintain the MCOLES Network as a **secure**, Web-based resource for basic training academies, law enforcement agencies, in-service training providers, and now individual law enforcement officers. One major component of the MCOLES Network security plan is strict adherence to the Security Policy by all users. Carefully read the entire policy statement before you apply for access. If you have any questions regarding your responsibility under the terms of the policy, please contact MCOLES.

Request Access

To request access to the MCOLES Network you must submit a completed Law Enforcement Officer [Access Agreement](#) to the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards. This form is available on the MCOLES public Web site as a PDF document. You can fill in the required information and print the form directly from the Web page.

Follow these steps to submit your request:

1. enter all the information requested in the on-line Agreement form
2. print a copy of the completed form
3. sign the Agreement
4. mail the original, signed Agreement to MCOLES together with:
 - a copy of your driver's license
 - one other piece of ID, e.g., department ID, birth certificate, passport
 - a stamped, self-addressed envelope

Notification

Once your request has been reviewed and processed by MCOLES, a written notification will be mailed to you in your self-addressed envelope. Please allow 10 business days from the date your request is received by MCOLES for processing. This notice will contain your user ID and a temporary password. The first time you log onto the MCOLES Network you will be required to change your password.
