

## **DPAC Membership Policy**

If a member of DPAC is inactive for a 12-month period, beginning October 1 in any given year, he/she will no longer be considered an active DPAC member. Individuals removed from the active membership list will receive written notification identifying that they have not fulfilled DPAC membership requirements within the past fiscal year in accordance with the DPAC Charter. The written notification will thank them for their past participation and provide options for continued involvement. If that member requests to remain on the active membership list, the Operations Manager will review with them DPAC membership guidelines based on our Charter. A firm commitment will be required from them in following the Charter membership guidelines for them to remain on the active membership list. If these individuals only want to receive information related to DPAC they will be referred to the DPAC website, and will no longer be considered an active DPAC member. 'Inactive' means that DPAC member did not attend a general membership meeting and did not participate in either four workgroups or four committee meetings within that fiscal year.
