

**SCOPE OF SERVICES  
FOR AS-NEEDED CONSTRUCTION SERVICES – QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

Geotechnical Engineering Services, Superior Region

Question 1: Under “Project Description” it indicates that it is expected that response be made within a 48 hour period “when needed”.

MISS DIG requires a minimum of 3 days notice and it was stated in the RFP that the TSC be notified 5 days prior to work. Is this requirement on an emergency basis only and will the TSC provide short notice approval of permitted work?

**Answer 1: The 48 hour response time is on an emergency basis only and only when MISS DIG responders are available to mark utilities within the expedited time requirement. On such emergency “projects” the TSC will provide short notice approval for the permitted work.**

Question 2: Under “Consultant Responsibilities” item #1 indicates that the consultant own the equipment necessary to perform the work. Does this extend to televising and videotaping sewers and culverts.

**Answer 2: The Consultant is required to own the equipment necessary to perform the soil boring work. The Consultant is not required to own televising and videotaping equipment.**
